# **Entry Forms now Online**

If you haven't sent in your application form yet, you have to do so by 9<sup>th</sup> March to avoid the late entry fee. It's very easy to complete the whole process with the online entry form and secure online payment. One thing to note - because the form will be filled in by only one person on behalf of any crew, we will require all paddlers to sign up to the standard Limitation of Liability when checking in at Devizes. This is particularly important for Junior Crews who will need to ensure that a suitable adult (parent or guardian) is on hand at the time of check-in. ### **RULES - Lighting on the Tideway for 4 day Racers**

We'd like to remind entrants to the 4 day events that the early tide time on the Monday will mean that all boats will need to carry appropriate lights. These must be produced for inspection at Devizes, though they need not be carried till the Monday. For full details of lighting rules, see the appropriate class rules on the website.

#### **RULES - Support Crews at Westminster**

While the finish line may seem a long way off at this point, we need the help of teams to manage the finish. Can we ask competitors and team managers to point out to support crews that the area at the top of the steps at Westminster is an alcohol free zone. That means no champagne. It's also worth remembering that many finishers will be arriving between 6 and 8 in the morning. It may be the finishing line of your personal challenge and goal, but at the top of the steps there is also a hotel, so keep the celebrations quiet please until your boat and support team get back to St Thomas' Gardens. Every person involved in the race has a responsibility to the future running of the race. Don't be the person, team or organisation that puts DW in a bad light. Thanks.

#### **Volunteers**

In short we still need them! From marshalling to manning checkpoints, checking crews, kit, assisting with safety. Down at Westminster there are tens of jobs needed over the Easter Weekend. If you have any time from a few hours to the whole weekend, please consider volunteering to help out. If Easter isn't a great time to give time, volunteering isn't just at race time. Throughout the year the race is planned and organized with a committee who piece together the broad range of support and skills required to make Devizes Westminster happen, as safely and smoothly as possible. And you don't have to be a paddler. We need about 300 volunteers to make DW work, and we need a constant supply of new recruits to learn the skills required and replace some of the old hands who are looking to retrieve their Easter. 
If you're still looking for a charity, DW are proud to support the <a href="Evelina Children's Hospital">Evelina Children's Hospital</a>


## Share Your DW - Facebook, YouTube, FlickR and more...
