DW2008 Race - What a Race?

Over 300 boats took part in the 60th anniversary race – a big increase on the previous year's 222 – and one we hope to maintain in 2009. Despite the gale force winds, biting cold and sub-zero temperatures the event brought out the strengths in the competitors who battled against icy covered boats, paddles, locks and clothing, standing waves created by headwinds on the Henley Straight and some of the worst conditions for years. Incredibly the drop-out rate overall was around one third. Over half of the non-stop crews retired as the one-tide finish took its toll. Over the four day event, the appalling conditions failed to beat the determined who battled against the elements.
